


Lexical Modeling of *Yamabuki*, (Japanese Kerria) in Classical Japanese Poetry



• Ide town in Kyoto is famous for its appearance in classical Japanese poety. (ca. 10th century; the *Heian* period)

• The Ide -Frog -Kerria combination is known as the **GOLDEN RATIO** of Classical Japanese Poetry.



• In addition, we discovered the hub node term *yahe* (eightfold) which plays a major role in connecting a topic word with other peripheral words but is not recorded in any poetic dictionaries.
