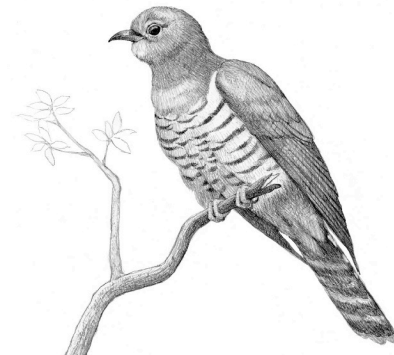
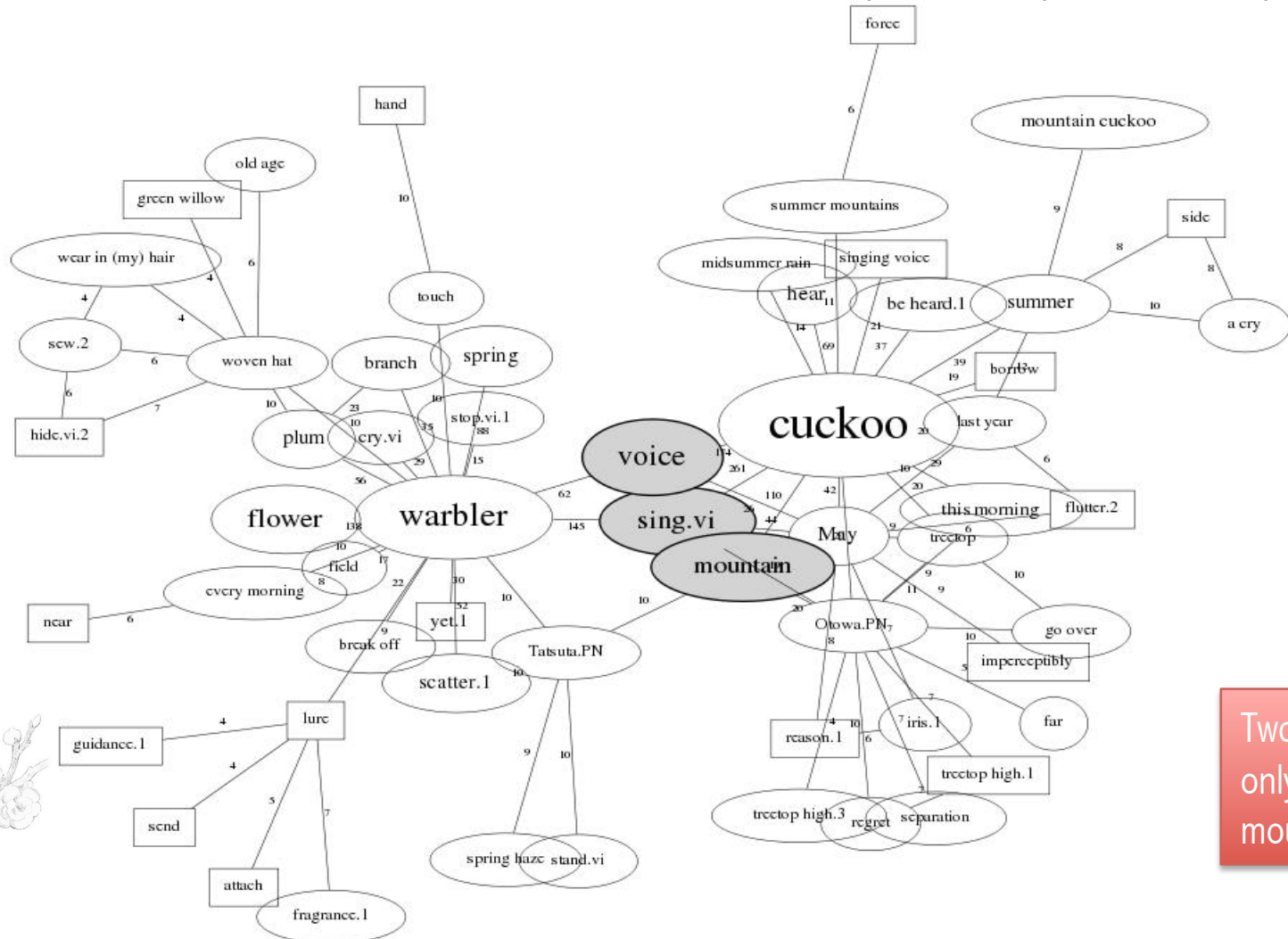
Computer modeling using co-occurrence patterns
