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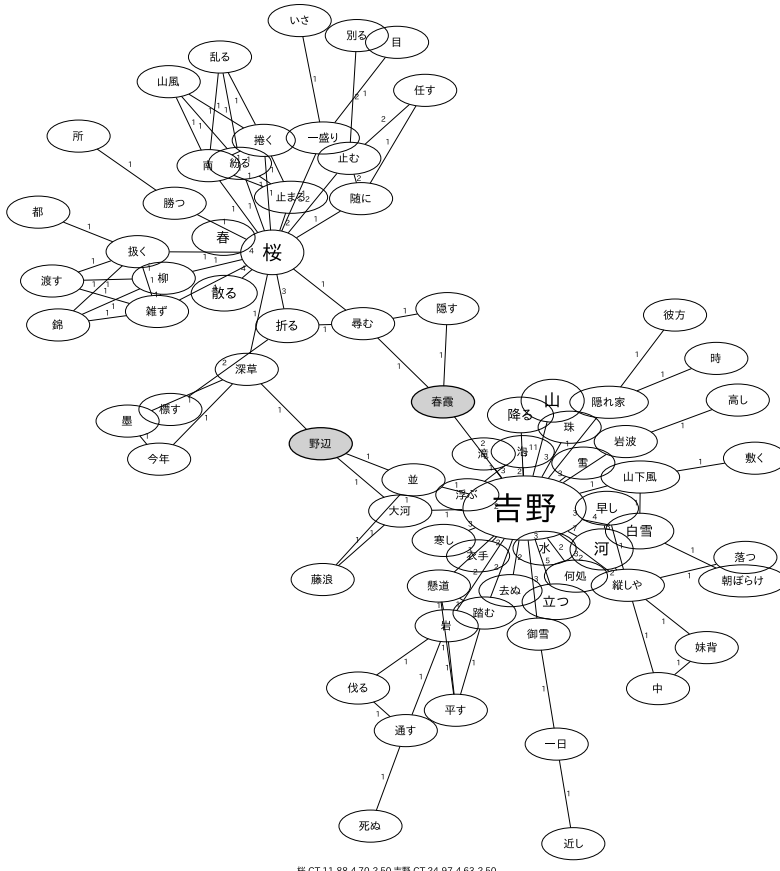


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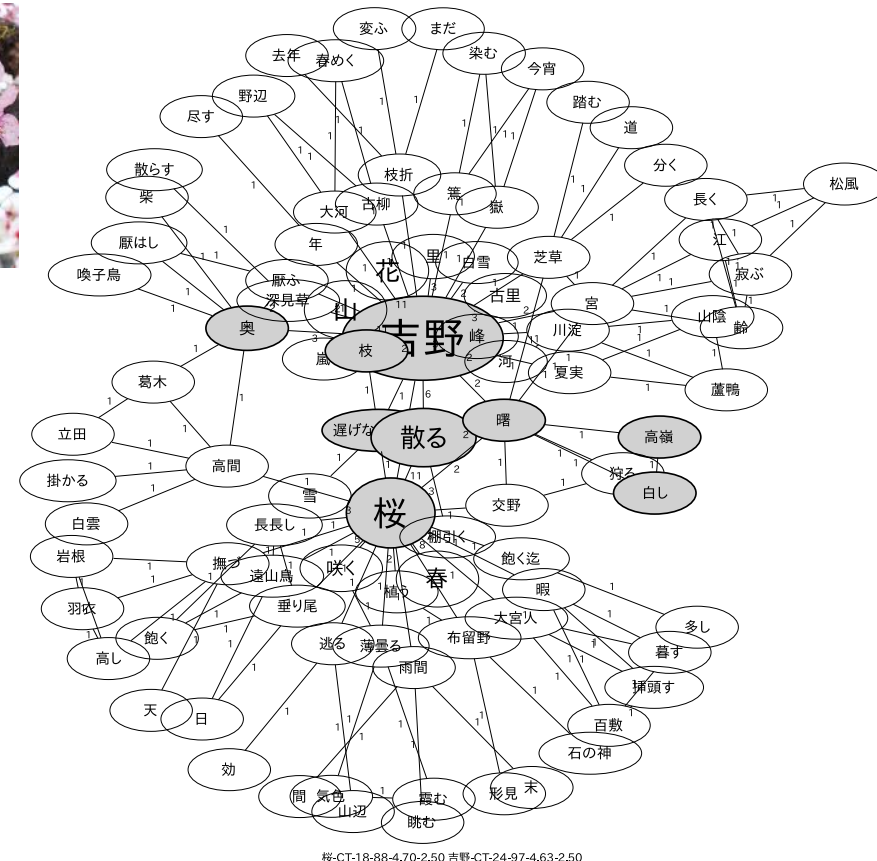
- Development of Diachronic Corpus by NINJAL; 2009–13, 4 year project.
